Public Safety Department (PSD)
Response if imminent life-safety threat is present:
PSD takes immediate action

Requests assistance, as needed:
Internal/External Agencies (i.e. EH&S, Fire Department, Emergency Services, etc.)
Immediately notifies:
FIU Office of Emergency Management (OEM)

University President and PPPG evaluates EMCC's, EMG's and/or PSD's report and achieves consensus

Incident is not an emergency:
No action required.

Contact relevant departments (Housing, UTS & Media Relations) for immediate, campus-wide, dispersal of information

Incident is an emergency:
An Incident Commander (IC) is designated by the President.

Each member of the Incident Command Structure (ICS) responds according to the needs of the IC.

Broadcast University-wide messages via Emergency Notification Systems: (Valcom, InformaCast & AlertFind)

IC instructs Public Information Officer (PIO) regarding key issues to be included in media releases.

PIO prepares media release per instructions and submits to the IC for approval.
