## -- Who Should Attend & Why --

The value of this training is an integral part of the National Preparedness Guidelines as set forth in HSPD 8 and is a FEMA/NPD/NIC/TEI certified curriculum. It will equip all institutions of higher education and the educational community and emergency responder disciplines, as well as other resources and entities in your jurisdiction (public schools, CERT, ARC, private sector businesses, major sporting venues, others as determined by the jurisdiction), with the necessary skills to become better prepared for all-hazards events by teaching a succession of assessments as site-specific in your jurisdiction.



The assessments completed by participants include a 1) Threat Assessment, 2) Vulnerability Assessment 3) Planning Factors (consequences), 4) Capabilities-based Planning Assessment, and a 5) Needs Assessment.

Additionally, discipline/entity "networking" is accomplished over the two-day class and participants, divided into teams, work through the process utilizing their expertise and professional knowledge, skills, and abilities: contributions from those present in performing the tabletops validates the *comprehensive, thorough, and precise assessments*.
